RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform Predictive & Preventive Maintenance (PPM) on mechanical equipment according to defined schedules and procedures. PPM's include lubrication, belt changes, measuring wear surfaces, torque equipment, and disassembling equipment for inspections.
- Troubleshoot, diagnose and provide effective repairs to all the components of Mechanical Equipment (primarily rotating equipment) including pumps, compressors, agitators, drive systems, conveyors, centrifuges, agitators, gearboxes, packlines, solids handling equipment, glass lined steel vessels, etc.
